

A few facts for prospective members of the Tamborine Mountain Golf Club.

The course was opened in 1958 and the Golf Club was established in 1962.

The 9 hole course is 5490 metres long with 2 tees on each hole providing variation. Par for 18 holes is 70 for men and 72 for ladies.

The Golf Club is Incorporated, managed by an elected Committee of 11 and is in a financially stable position.

Competitions are conducted on Tuesday mornings – ladies, Wednesday mornings – Veterans, Thursday – Thursday Club, and Saturday – members. Timesheets are used on Saturday. On other days, turn up at the designated time.

Members can play casually at any time respecting the rights of competition players to have priority right of play.

New members pay a joining fee of \$100 and the annual fees for 2008/9 will be \$520 plus GST. Fees are due on October 1 each year. Fees are paid for competitions. Membership application forms are available on the website and at the Pro Shop.

Light meals and drinks are available at designated times as it is not feasible financially to keep the Clubhouse open at all times.

The Club Professional, Andy Koureas (07 55451788) is available for tuition, sells and hires equipment including motorized carts and can be contacted to arrange a game.
